



## 2011 Canada Winter Games Assistant Coach – Job Description

The Manitoba Speed Skating Association is seeking applications for a female Assistant Coach for the 2011 Canada Winter Games in Halifax Nova Scotia from February 10 – 19, 2011. The female coach will head either Manitoba's Short Track or Long Track Team at the games.

Applicants will be evaluated by the High Performance Committee and judged to the extent of meeting the determined qualifications for the position. A combination of one male and one female will form the coach-manager support team for each discipline.

### Qualifications:

- Must be available to attend the Canada Winter Games in Halifax, NS from February 10 – 19, 2011.
- A minimum of NCCP Level 3 or Competition Development Coach Certification.
- Sport Manitoba's Respect in Sport Certification.
- The successful applicant must provide a child abuse and criminal record check.

### Position:

- Work closely with the CWG Head Coach and Managers.
- Responsible for ensuring that CWG athletes comply with both the Sport MB and MSSA Athlete Codes of Conduct.
- Coach at Manitoba based training camps and designated out of province camps.
- Coach at designated competitions in accordance with CWG preparation/training schedule.
- Coach at designated pre-season dry-land training sessions.
- Coach at designated ice/dryland training sessions throughout the racing season leading up to and including the CWG.
- Assist the Head Coach in development of training program and classroom sessions/seminars.
- Should there be a conflict in the competition schedule with short and long track meets, the Assistant Coach will be responsible to accompany the athletes to the meet assigned by the CWG committee.
- Should there be training sessions for the long and short track scheduled at the same time, the Assistant Coach will be responsible for conducting the practice as assigned by the CWG committee.
- Together with the Head Coach and Managers assist with the decision making process in relation to the formulation of the short and long track teams.
- Together with the Head Coach and Managers assist with scheduling of practice, racing, and recreational activities at the CWG.
- Preference will be given to those who do not have a child competing for a spot at the 2011 CWG.
- Out of province coaches will be considered and are welcome to apply.
